Statement of Commitment

I, _____, wish to be a member of the 2015-2016 CCPA Community Show Choir. I understand that I must attend ALL rehearsals and performances/competitions. **I understand that if I miss 3 or more rehearsals that are unexcused, then I will no longer be a member of the ensemble.** I also understand that I will have to pay for (or fundraise for) my costumes, a nominal monthly rehearsal fee (approx. \$7), a one-time choreography/music fee (\$50), as well as pay for competition trips (approx. \$300 total). I understand that this is a financial commitment I must honor.

I am aware that there is a MANDATORY Choreography week that will likely consists of six days of intensive choreography from a professional choreographer from California (dates/times TBA as soon as possible). I also understand that regular weekly rehearsals will tentatively begin on **Monday, August 24th** and will continue throughout the school year on Mondays from 4:30-6:30 PM and Saturdays from 12:30-2:30 PM. I am willing and able to commit to this rehearsal schedule. I will also be flexible if any necessary changes in the schedule should come up.

Finally, I understand that as a member of the CCPS Community Show Choir, I will be expected to always be a good representative of Cape Coral Performing Arts, as my behavior and attitude reflects not only on me, but on those whom I represent.
